RESULT 1

Boys have significantly more screen time (ST) than girls, but they also accumulate more outdoor



ST (min/d)	49.6	42.4
OP (min/d)	150.3	144.7

Urbanization and parental employment were the factors most associated with children's time use along the day.

RESULT 2



Children who sleep more and those practicing a sport have lower screen time.
