between the time children spend

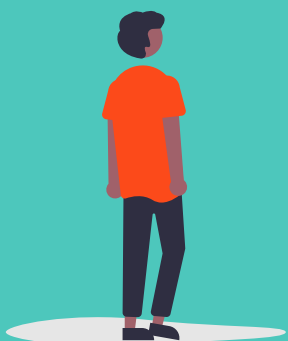
in different activities?

RESULT 1

Boys have significantly more **screen time (ST)** than girls, but they also accumulate more **outdoor play (OP)**.



ST (min/d)	49.6	42.4
OP (min/d)	150.3	144.7

RESULT 2

Urbanization and **parental employment** were the factors most associated with children's time use along the day.



RESULT 3

Children who **sleep** more and those practicing a **sport** have lower **screen time**.



Present findings highlight the growing importance of electronic media in children's life and how they can displace other leisure activities.
