FINDINGS:

- Board play in the offensive zone, is a crucial tactical aspect of scoring goals, both during even strength and power play situations.
- Another key factor for scoring is being active and recovering the puck as close to the opponent's goal as possible.
- Additionally, quick transitions are essential for scoring. When teams use fast attacks and counterattacks, the opponent doesn't have time to organize their defense, making it easier to score goals.
