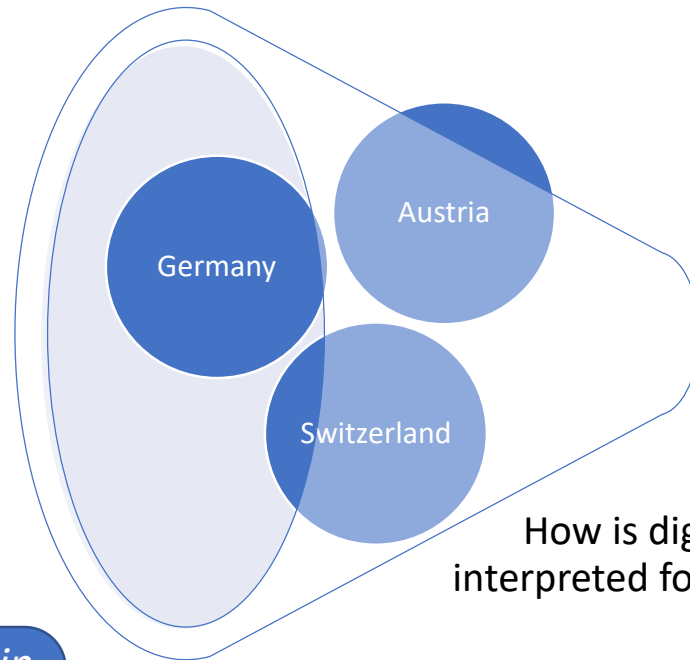


# Talking 'bout digitalization. An analysis of PE curricula in German-speaking countries

PE plays a major role in preparing the next generation for using digital technologies within PA competently, while at the same time taking a constructive and critical perspective on the potentials and risks.



PE's dual mission (learning *in* and *through* physical activity) and digital dual mission (learning *with* and *about* digital media).

➤ Substantial reference to digitalization is made only in German curricula.

➤➤ Digital media appear with a predominantly functional character

➤➤ The critical reflection embedded in media is only rarely addressed

➤➤ The rhetoric of digitalization in is at best a reductionist understanding of PE's dual mission

How is digitalization interpreted for PE curricula?

Future curriculum reforms should address digitalization and PE in a more comprehensive way to empower students critically navigating through sport and movement in the digital realm.
